



Mission

The aim of the Children's Ministry at Trinity Presbyterian Church is to guide children to encounter the loving God, embrace the gospel of Christ, and to participate in the Spirit-formed community.

Core Values

1. A focus on the gospel in the story of creation, fall, redemption, and new creation and in the doctrinal wisdom of Scripture.
2. An intention that children participate in the listening, learning, and worship of God.
3. An emphasis on compassion for others and service in the Kingdom in response to the generous love of God the Father.

Sunday Mornings

1. Nursery (0-3 years): During Worship Service and Sunday School hour.
2. Children's Church (3 years old-1st grade): During the sermon, we offer a time tailored specifically for children in which we learn some of the songs we sing at church, spend some time, pray, begin to memorize foundations of our faith like the Apostles' Creed and the Lord's Prayer, and hear a Bible story.
3. Sunday School (3 years old-5th grade): During the school year, at 11 AM we have Children's Sunday School, an hour in which children gather with their peers to grow in their understanding of the gospel message and its meaning for their lives now.

Teachers

All of our Children's Ministry classes (including nursery) have at least two teachers, and all teachers undergo a background check.
